The Industry Promotion Fund (Fonds de Promotion de l'Industrie, FPI) is a public body, created 20 years ago, and aimed at helping the industrial sector to develop itself within the Democratic Republic of Congo. Based in Kinshasa, with subsidiaries in the various provinces of the country, the FPI has supported, up to now, more than 600 projects.

For more than 10 years, ICHEC Formation Continue and the FPI have shared a close relationship. Five Management Programs have been organized

The FPI is financed by the Government through a special tax on imported goods. It is now facing the challenge to consolidate and grow its financial resources in order to meet the continuously

increasing needs of the Congolese industrial sector and therefore sustain its increasing competitiveness.

The FPI also faces several other major challenges, among which the need to gradually become financially independent of public subsidies. Thanks to its financial expertise, it is also likely to play a major role in the soon-to-come launch of the Kinshasa Stock Market.

In order to work on these fantastic challenges, a new training program has been designed for 10 selected Managers from the FPI. This Financial Engineering Program has just been conducted, in April 2016, within the premises of ICHEC Brussels Management School in Brussels. These were three exciting and intensive weeks!
